Revenue Summary

House Bill 2668 is funded with General Fund appropriations and the bill has no long-term impacts on the revenues of the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) or the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC).

Summary of Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee Action

House Bill 2668 prohibits ODA from issuing an industrial hemp or hemp seed production license to applicants that have an industrial hemp operation within 1,000 feet of a school. ODA is directed to rescind current licenses of growers that are within 1,000 feet of a school and to provide just compensation if the grower incurred costs prior to the revocation. Initial estimates for just compensation are anticipated to be \$500-\$750 per acre. The bill also directs ODA and the Oregon State University College of Agriculture Sciences to conduct research on currently licensed industrial hemp operations related to the following topics:

- Safe growing distance between industrial hemp operations and marijuana operations to ensure purity of corps and reduce the risk of cross-pollination
- The feasibility of growing industrial hemp for fiber
- The feasibility of growing industrial hemp for seed
- The use of water in cultivating industrial hemp
- The tendency of industrial hemp to become feral

Department of Agriculture

The Subcommittee approved a one-time \$100,000 General Fund appropriation to ODA for rule-making and to provide compensation to eligible growers of industrial hemp as specified in the bill.

Higher Education Coordinating Commission

The Subcommittee approved a one-time \$290,000 General Fund appropriation to HECC to be transferred to the Oregon State University College of Agricultural Sciences to conduct research as specified in the bill.
