- AMENDS CONSTITUTION: AUTHORIZES IMPOSITION OF LOCAL OPTION PROPERTY
 TAXES OUTSIDE CERTAIN CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS AND FREEZES ASSESSED
 VALUE OF HOMESTEADS OF CERTAIN SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILI TIES.

RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "Yes" vote allows local taxing districts to impose, for up to 10 years, voter-approved local option ad valorem property taxes that are not subject to constitutional limitations on property taxation and collection and requires enactment of property tax relief program that freezes assessed value of homesteads of individuals eligible by age or disability.

RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "No" vote retains current constitutional limitations on local option ad valorem property taxes and current determination of assessed value for homesteads of certain seniors and individuals with disabilities.

SUMMARY: This measure authorizes local taxing districts to impose, for up to 10 years, local option ad valorem property taxes outside the limitations on property taxation and collection imposed by Article XI, section 11b, of the Oregon Constitution (Ballot Measures 5 and 50), if approved by voters.

The measure also requires the Legislative Assembly to enact a property tax relief program that freezes the assessed value of the homesteads of individuals eligible by age or disability.

3	SECTION 2. The ballot title in section 1 of this 2015 Act shall be printed in the voters'
4	pamphlet and on the ballot.
5	SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
6	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
7	on its passage.
