## AN ACT

Relating to school lunches; and declaring an emergency.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) If a student is eligible for reduced price lunches under the United States Department of Agriculture's current Income Eligibility Guidelines, the school district that provides lunches to the student shall provide the lunches at no charge to the student.

(2) For each lunch that a school district provides free of charge to a student who is eligible for a reduced price lunch, the Department of Education shall provide reimbursement to the school district for the actual amount that the student would have been required to pay for the reduced price lunch.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act first applies to reduced price lunches provided during the 2015-2016 school year.

SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.
