## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2578

Delete lines 4 through 13 of the printed bill and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 443.850 to 3 443.869. "SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section: 4  $\mathbf{5}$ "(a) 'Personal representative' has the meaning given that term in ORS 111.005. 6 "(b) 'Residential cable service' means the transmission of any communication to a resi-7 dential customer of the service for the purpose of delivering video content to the customer. "(c) 'Residential telecommunications service' means the transmission of any communi-8 9 cation between a residential customer of the service and any other individual through the 10 use of a communication system established and maintained by a radio common carrier or a telecommunications utility, both as defined in ORS 759.005. 11 12"(2) An individual in a hospice program, or the next of kin or personal representative of 13 an individual who has died, may terminate, without penalty, a residential cable service or a 14 residential telecommunications service provided pursuant to an existing contract. 15"(3) For purposes described in subsection (2) of this section, a provider of a residential 16 cable service or a residential telecommunications service may require an individual in a 17 hospice program or the next of kin or personal representative of an individual who has died 18 to submit a document establishing that the individual is in a hospice program or has died. "(4) A termination of service under subsection (2) of this section is effective on the date 19 20 on which the provider of the service first receives notice that the individual is in a hospice 21program or has died. 22(5) The Oregon Health Authority may impose a civil penalty, not to exceed \$1,000, for violation of this section. Civil penalties imposed under this section shall be imposed in the 2324 manner provided by ORS 183.745. All moneys recovered under this section shall be paid into 25the State Treasury and credited to the General Fund.

<u>"SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to contracts entered into or renewed on
or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.".
