Requires electric companies to account for external cost of carbon in integrated resource plans submitted to Public Utility Commission.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to pollutants emitted by facilities that generate electricity. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 757. 4

SECTION 2. The Public Utility Commission shall require an electric company, as defined 5

6 in ORS 757.600, to account for the external cost of carbon in any plan submitted to the

7 commission that proposes an integrated, least-cost combination of resources that meets the

8 expected needs of the electric company's customers. For purposes of this section, the State

9 Department of Energy shall establish the external cost of carbon by rule, taking into account

any information on the social cost of carbon as determined by the United States Environ-10 mental Protection Agency.

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
