House Bill 2645

Sponsored by Representative WITT (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires community colleges and public universities to establish priority enrollment system for qualified students who are active members of Armed Forces of the United States or qualified veterans.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a priority enrollment system for certain qualified persons.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section:

5 (a) "Active member of the Armed Forces of the United States" and "Armed Forces of the

6 United States" have the meaning given those terms in ORS 351.642.

7 (b) "Community college" has the meaning given that term in ORS 341.005.

8 (c) "Qualified student" means a student who:

9 (A) Is an active member of the Armed Forces of the United States or served in the 10 Armed Forces of the United States;

(B) If a former member of the Armed Forces of the United States, was relieved or dis charged from that service with either an honorable discharge or a general discharge under
 honorable conditions;

(C) Provides proof that the student has established a physical presence in Oregon within
 12 months of being enrolled at a community college or public university; and

(D) Has been certified by the Department of Veterans' Affairs for taking classes at a
 community college or a public university.

(2) Subject to subsections (3) and (4) of this section, a community college or a public
 university listed in ORS 352.002, in consultation with the department, shall establish a pri ority enrollment system by which a qualified student is prioritized over nonqualified students
 for registration for enrollment at the community college or the public university.

(3)(a) A qualified student must apply for priority registration for enrollment as provided
in this section within 10 academic years after the qualified student becomes an active member of the Armed Forces of the United States or, if the student is a former member of the
Armed Forces of the United States, within 10 academic years after the student leaves state
or federal active duty.

(b) The priority provided under this section terminates 15 years after the qualified student
dent becomes an active member of the Armed Forces of the United States or, if the student
is a former member of the Armed Forces of the United States, 15 years after the student
leaves state or federal active duty.

31 (4) The priority system established pursuant to this section must, at a minimum, provide

1 that a qualified student has priority registration for enrollment over persons who are not

2 qualified students and who are registering for the first time for enrollment at a community

3 college or public university listed in ORS 352.002.

4 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2015 Act applies only to qualified students applying as new 5 or continuing students for enrollment at a community college or a public university on or 6 after September 15, 2016.
