## House Bill 2650

Sponsored by Representatives KOMP, NATHANSON (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs State Library to distribute grants to school districts for early reading programs provided during summer.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to summer education programs; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. (1) The State Library shall distribute grants to school districts for early reading programs provided during the summer. The State Library shall administer the grants with the assistance of the Department of Education.
  - (2) A school district may receive a grant under this section if:
  - (a) The school district serves lunch at a school in the school district during the summer as a part of:
    - (A) The United States Department of Agriculture's Summer Food Service Program; or
  - (B) A summer meals program through an existing national school lunch program; and
  - (b) At least 50 percent of the students of the school where the school district serves lunch:
- 14 (A) Read below grade level after third grade; or
  - (B) Are at risk of reading below grade level after third grade.
  - (3) Any school district with a school that meets the qualifications described in subsection (2) of this section may apply for a grant under this section. The department shall assist the State Library in determining if a school district that applies for a grant has a school that meets the requirements.
  - (4) A school district that receives a grant under this section must ensure that the school where lunch is served provides:
    - (a) Access to the school library; and
      - (b) Literacy activities or expanded learning opportunities.
- 24 (5) The services described in subsection (4) of this section must be provided at a school 25 for at least six weeks during the summer.
  - (6) The State Library, in consultation with the department:
- 27 (a) Shall establish:
- 28 (A) The minimum number of hours that a school library must be accessible; and
- 29 (B) Criteria for literacy activities and expanded learning opportunities.
- 30 **(b) May establish:** 
  - (A) Tiers of grant requirements and grant amounts; and
