SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Provides exception to offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle for persons operating farm vehicle **or engaged in commercial agriculture.**

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to exceptions to the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle; creating
3 new provisions; and amending ORS 811.200.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 811.200 is amended to read:

6 811.200. (1) A person commits the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle if
7 the person carries a dog upon the hood, fender, running board or other external part of any auto-
8 mobile or truck that is upon a highway unless the dog is protected by framework, carrier or other
9 device sufficient to keep it from falling from the vehicle.

10 **(2) A person does not commit the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a**
11 **vehicle if, at the time the conduct occurs, the person is:**

12 **(a) Operating a farm vehicle registered under ORS 805.300; or**

13 **(b) Engaged in commercial agriculture.**

14 ~~[(2)]~~ **(3)** The offense described in this section, carrying a dog on **the** external part of a vehicle,
15 is a Class D traffic violation.

16 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 811.200 by section 1 of this 2015 Act apply to of-
17 fenses occurring on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.
