Delete lines 5 through 15 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. ORS 811.200 is amended to read: 3 "811.200. (1) A person commits the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle if the person carries a dog upon the hood, fender, running board, truck bed or other external part 4 5 of any automobile or truck that is upon a highway unless the dog is [protected by framework, carrier or other device sufficient to keep it from falling from the vehicle.] in an enclosed space or, if the 6 space is not enclosed, the dog is otherwise protected in a manner that will prevent the dog 7 from being thrown, falling or jumping from the vehicle, including but not limited to the fol-8 9 lowing: 10 "(a) Securing the dog in a truck bed with walls that are at least 46 inches in height; "(b) Cross tethering the dog to the vehicle; or 11 "(c) Placing the dog in a container or cage that is secured to the vehicle. 12"(2) A person does not commit the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a 13 14 vehicle if, at the time the conduct occurs, the person is: 15"(a) Operating a farm vehicle registered under ORS 805.300; or "(b) Engaged in commercial agriculture. 16 "[(2)] (3) The offense described in this section, carrying \mathbf{a} dog on the external part of \mathbf{a} vehicle, 17 18 is a Class D traffic violation.". 19
