House Bill 2832

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires public university or community college that contracts with financial institution, organization or other institution for student financial aid services to make contract publicly available.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to contracts for student financial aid services.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "financial institution" has the meaning given that 5 term in ORS 706.008.

(2) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 or a community college in this state that 6 contracts with a financial institution, organization or other institution to permit the finan-7 8 cial institution, organization or other institution to provide disbursement and management services of financial aid funds to students enrolled in the public university or community 9 college shall make the contract available for public inspection and shall at a minimum pub-10 lish the contract on the website operated by or for the public university or community col-11 lege. 12 (3) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission may adopt rules regarding: 13

(a) Other methods by which a contract described in subsection (2) of this section may
be disseminated to the public; and

(b) The organizations and other institutions to which the requirements of subsection (2)
of this 2015 Act apply.

(4) A public university or community college may redact from a contract described in
subsection (2) of this section material that is exempt from disclosure under ORS 192.410 to
192.505 before publishing or otherwise making available the contract.

21 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The requirements of section 1 of this 2015 Act apply to contracts entered 22 into or modified on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.
