House Bill 2906

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies definition of "scientifically based research" with respect to evidence-based programs.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to scientifically based research; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 182.515.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 182.515 is amended to read:
5	182.515. As used in this section and ORS 182.525:
6	(1) "Agency" means:
7	(a) The Department of Corrections;
8	(b) The Oregon Youth Authority;
9	(c) The Youth Development Division; and
10	(d) That part of the Oregon Health Authority that deals with mental health and addiction issues.
11	(2) "Cost-effective" means that benefits realized over a reasonable period of time are greater
12	than costs, as determined utilizing a cost-benefit analytical tool identified by the Oregon Criminal
13	Justice Commission.
14	(3) "Evidence-based program" means a program that:
15	(a) Incorporates significant and relevant practices based on scientifically based research; and
16	(b) Is cost-effective.
17	(4)(a) "Program" means a treatment or intervention program or service that is intended to:
18	(A) Reduce the propensity of a person to commit crimes;
19	(B) Improve the mental health of a person with the result of reducing the likelihood that the
20	person will commit a crime or need emergency mental health services; or
21	(C) Reduce the propensity of a person who is less than 18 years of age to engage in antisocial
22	behavior with the result of reducing the likelihood that the person will become a juvenile offender.
23	(b) "Program" does not include:
24	(A) An educational program or service that an agency is required to provide to meet educational
25	requirements imposed by state law; or
26	(B) A program that provides basic medical services.
27	(5) "Scientifically based research" means [research that obtains reliable and valid knowledge
28	by:] scientific evaluation that is rigorous, independent and credible and includes, at a mini-
29	mum, scientific evaluation that:
30	[(a) Employing systematic, empirical methods that draw on observation or experiment;]
31	[(b) Involving rigorous data analyses that are adequate to test the stated hypotheses and justify the

1 [(c) Relying on measurements or observational methods that provide reliable and valid data across $\mathbf{2}$ evaluators and observers, across multiple measurements and observations and across studies by the 3 same or different investigators; and] [(d) Utilizing randomized controlled trials when possible and appropriate.] 4 $\mathbf{5}$ (a) Is conducted independently of any organization that has implemented, funded or supported a program; 6 (b) Includes any individual who was originally enrolled in a program regardless of 7whether the originally enrolled individual completed the program; and 8 9 (c) Is conducted pursuant to an experimental design using rigorous, scientific methods to randomize the pool of participants and comparisons made among participants. 10 11 SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 182.515 by section 1 of this 2015 Act apply to 12evidence-based programs implemented on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act. 13
