SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires insurer or third party administrator to reimburse health care provider for fees charged to provider by credit card company that processes payments.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to payment of insurance claims.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.

5 SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:

6 (a) "Credit card" has the meaning given that term in 15 U.S.C. 1602.

7 (b) "Health benefit plan" has the meaning given that term in ORS 743.730.

8 (2) An insurer or a third party administrator that pays a claim submitted to a health

9 benefit plan by an in-network or contracted health care provider through the use of a credit

10 card shall reimburse the provider for any fees charged to the provider by the credit card

11 company for processing the payment.

12 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to payment of claims under contracts en-13 tered into between health care providers and insurers or third party administrators, on or 14 after the effective date of this 2015 Act.

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
