1 Delete lines 5 through 21 of the printed bill and insert:

2 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Each school district shall allow the following during school hours, at a 3 school-sponsored activity or while under the supervision of school personnel:

"(a) The outdoor use by students of sun-protective clothing, including hats.

5 "(b) The application of and use by students of nonprescription sunscreen, including 6 sunscreen that contains para-aminobenzoic acid, without any required documentation from 7 a licensed health care professional.

8 "(2) Nothing in subsection (1)(a) of this section prevents a school district from prohibit-9 ing certain clothing or hats based on the inappropriateness of the graphics, color or message 10 of the clothing or hats.

11 "(3) A school district may allow school personnel to assist students in applying 12 nonprescription sunscreen but may not require school personnel to assist students in apply-13 ing nonprescription sunscreen.

14 "(4) School personnel may not be held liable in a criminal action or for civil damages for 15 application of nonprescription sunscreen, including sunscreen that contains para-16 aminobenzoic acid, if the nonprescription sunscreen is available to and used by the student 17 in accordance with this section.".
