SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Authorizes rural ports to acquire and operate telecommunications [infrastructure and] facilities.

2 Relating to authority of ports.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 777.005 to 5 777.725.

6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) A rural port may construct, purchase, acquire, develop, finance, lease, 7 license, handle, provide, add to, contract for, interconnect, alter, improve, repair, operate 8 and maintain any telecommunications facilities within or without the port's limits for the 9 port's own use.

10 (2) This section does not authorize a rural port to provide telecommunications services
11 to end users.

(3) A rural port may not exercise powers of eminent domain to acquire telecommuni cations infrastructure or facilities or contractual rights to telecommunications
infrastructure or facilities held by any other person or entity.

(4) As used in this section, "rural port" means a port that has a population of less than
750,000 within its territorial boundaries.
