

# House Bill 3127

Sponsored by Representative EVANS; Representatives BARTON, DAVIS, ESQUIVEL, GILLIAM, HUFFMAN, NATHANSON, NOSSE

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that amounts appropriated from any fund for unemployment insurance-related purposes and programs may not be expended for any purpose or program not directly related to purposes and programs authorized or required under provisions of unemployment insurance statutes.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to expenditures from unemployment insurance-related funds; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 657.**

5 **SECTION 2. Amounts appropriated from any fund created under the provisions of this**  
6 **chapter or under ORS 294.730 may not be expended for any purpose or program that is not**  
7 **directly related to the purposes and programs authorized or required under the provisions**  
8 **of this chapter.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**  
11 **on its passage.**
