

House Bill 3319

Sponsored by Representative TAYLOR

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to evaluate methods to reduce dropout rates.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to dropout prevention; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall evaluate methods to reduce dropout**
5 **rates, including limiting the ability of a student to drop out of school.**

6 **(2) The department shall submit a report on the evaluation described in subsection (1)**
7 **of this section to the interim legislative committees on education no later than September**
8 **15, 2015.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
