

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3406

- 1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert “amending ORS 181.685;”.
- 2 Delete lines 4 through 28 and insert:
- 3 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 181.685 is amended to read:
- 4 “181.685. (1) The Oregon Center for Policing Excellence is established within the Department
- 5 of Public Safety Standards and Training.
- 6 “(2) The primary purposes of the center are:
- 7 “(a) To make policing in this state more effective and efficient by:
- 8 “(A) Developing and promulgating updated skills in policing among officers, managers and ad-
- 9 ministrators; and
- 10 “(B) Making use of the body of knowledge of effective and efficient methods in the criminal
- 11 justice system.
- 12 “(b) To make communities safer.
- 13 “(c) To reduce, through the use of police practices proven to be effective, the number of
- 14 offenders entering the criminal justice system.
- 15 **“(d) To assist with recruiting and community outreach.**
- 16 “(3) To accomplish the purposes described in subsection (2) of this section, the center shall
- 17 provide opportunities for:
- 18 “(a) Practitioners to present actual problems to researchers in order to identify potential ap-
- 19 proaches to resolving the problems.
- 20 “(b) Researchers to present to practitioners the results of research on effective and efficient
- 21 methods of policing.
- 22 “(c) Practitioners and researchers to form partnerships to test the effectiveness of practices and
- 23 approaches.
- 24 “(d) The development and delivery of training to public safety personnel in this state to enhance
- 25 their skills related to:
- 26 “(A) Problem solving;
- 27 “(B) Leadership and facilitation;
- 28 “(C) Effective application and use of information from reputable research; and
- 29 “(D) Identifying and addressing future challenges affecting public safety.
- 30 “(4) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, and local government, as de-
- 31 fined in ORS 174.116, are directed to cooperate with the center in achieving the purposes described
- 32 in subsection (2) of this section.
- 33 “(5) The Director of the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training may adopt rules
- 34 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
- 35 **“SECTION 2.** This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

1 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
2 **on its passage.”**

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
