House Bill 3456

Sponsored by Representative WEIDNER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires health benefit plan to reimburse cost of care provided by licensed direct entry midwife at freestanding birthing center if care would be reimbursed if provided by licensed physician or certified nurse practitioner in hospital setting.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to reimbursement for cost of care provided by direct entry midwife; amending ORS
 743A.080.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 743A.080 is amended to read:

6 743A.080. (1) As used in this section, "pregnancy care" means the care necessary to support a 7 healthy pregnancy and care related to labor and delivery.

8 (2) All health benefit plans as defined in ORS 743.730 must provide payment or reimbursement

9 for expenses associated with pregnancy care and childbirth. Benefits provided under this section
10 shall be extended to all enrollees, enrolled spouses and enrolled dependents.

(3) A health benefit plan shall reimburse a direct entry midwife licensed under ORS
687.405 to 687.495 for the cost of pregnancy care and postnatal care provided at a freestanding
birthing center as defined in ORS 442.015 if the care would be reimbursed if provided by a
licensed physician or certified nurse practitioner in a hospital setting.

(4) If an association of birthing centers formed in this state develops and publishes re commended prices for affordable pregnancy care and postnatal care provided at a birthing
 center, the reimbursement paid under subsection (3) of this section may not be less than the
 published prices.

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
