CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Justice; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$11,644,429, for the following purposes:

(1) Paying expenses of district attorneys, as provided in section 2 of this 2015 Act; and

(2) Paying the expenses incurred in administering this section and section 2 of this 2015 Act, as provided in section 3 of this 2015 Act.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, may allocate moneys from the appropriation made by section 1 of this 2015 Act for the payment of expenses of district attorneys.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, may allocate moneys from the appropriation made by section 1 of this 2015 Act for the payment of expenses incurred in administering sections 1 and 2 of this 2015 Act.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.
