

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5019

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 25 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following
4 purposes:

- 5 (1) Fire protection..... \$ 43,336,914
6 (2) Private forests \$ 16,680,329
7 (3) Debt service \$ 2,920,698

8 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
9 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment
10 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and in-
11 cluding federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection and for re-
12 search projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section,
13 collected or received by the State Forestry Department, for the following purposes:

- 14 (1) Agency administration..... \$ 31,094,178
15 (2) Fire protection..... \$ 66,225,597
16 (3) State forests \$ 90,183,517
17 (4) Private forests \$ 10,730,762
18 (5) Capital improvement..... \$ 4,444,222
19 (6) Debt service \$ 1,928,275
20 (7) Equipment pool..... \$ 15,816,835
21 (8) Facilities maintenance
22 and management..... \$ 5,233,069

23 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
24 \$2,481,960 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for
25 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-
26 nomic Development Fund to the State Forestry Department for debt service relating to the
27 purchase of land in the Gilchrist Forest.

28 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
29 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment
30 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2015 Act, col-
31 lected or received by the State Forestry Department, for the following purposes:

- 32 (1) Agency administration..... \$ 1,908,377
33 (2) Fire protection..... \$ 16,280,192
34 (3) State forests \$ 3,864,874
35 (4) Private forests \$ 12,739,822

1 **“SECTION 5. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-**
2 **propriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the**
3 **General Fund, the amount of \$6,000,000, to be allocated to the State Forestry Department for**
4 **fire protection expenses.**

5 **“(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**
6 **by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2016, the moneys remaining on that date be-**
7 **come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

8 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
9 **\$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for**
10 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**
11 **nomic Development Fund to the State Forestry Department for agency administration.**

12 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
13 **expenditures established by section 4 (3), chapter 620, Oregon Laws 2013, for state forests,**
14 **as modified by legislative or Emergency Board action, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
15 **2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds other than those**
16 **described in section 2, chapter 620, Oregon Laws 2013, collected or received by State Forestry**
17 **Department, is decreased by \$3,000,000.**

18 **“SECTION 8. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
20 **on its passage.”.**

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
