Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitations on 4 expenditures established by section 2, chapter , Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses 6

from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax receipts, 7

provider taxes, Medicare receipts and federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Supplemental 8

Security Income recoveries, Women, Infants and Children Program food rebates, the Coor-9

dinated School Health Program, the Edward Byrne Memorial State and Local Law Enforce-10

11 ment Assistance Grant Program, homeland security and emergency preparedness and

response services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, 12

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on 6 expenditures established by section 2 (4), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 7 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses 8 9 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security 10 Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and 11 federal funds not described in section 2, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 12 5026), collected or received by the Department of Human Services, is increased by \$386,411. 13

14 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 15 \$1,100,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for 16 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts 17 and reimbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal 18 funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Department of Revenue, for 19 the core system replacement project.

20SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 21225035), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses 23from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described 94 in section 2, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5035), collected or received 25by the Department of Revenue, is increased by \$145,544 for the purpose of implementing 2627chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2041).

SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on 28expenditures established by section 2 (4), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2930 5035), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses 31 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described 32in section 2, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5035), collected or received 33 34 by the Department of Revenue, is increased by \$618,909 for the purpose of implementing chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2041). 35

<u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5002), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and including federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5002), collected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, is increased by \$212,641.

43 <u>SECTION 7.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 44 \$8,332,933 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for 45 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,

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but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Liquor
Control Commission, from the Oregon Liquor Control Commission Account and the
Marijuana Control and Regulation Fund for expenses related to the regulation of recreational

4 marijuana.

5 <u>SECTION 8.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 6 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 7 July 1, 2015.

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
