## AN ACT

Relating to all-terrain vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Parks and Recreation Department shall convene a work group that includes users of all-terrain vehicles, all-terrain vehicle dealers, staff from the Department of Transportation and other individuals whom the State Parks and Recreation Department deems necessary, for the purpose of examining options for allowing users of all-terrain vehicles to operate on state highways.

(2) The department shall compile a report, including any recommendations for legislation, of the work group's conclusions.

(3) The department shall submit the report to the appropriate interim committee of the Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, not later than September 15, 2016.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on December 31, 2016.
