Enrolled Senate Bill 285

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CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to nursing assistants; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 678.440.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 678.440 is amended to read:

678.440. (1) As used in this section and ORS 678.442, 678.444 and 678.445 and section 3 of this 2015 Act, "nursing assistant" means an individual who assists licensed nursing personnel in the provision of nursing care.

[(1)] (2) It is the intent of the Legislative Assembly to require that nursing assistants be adequately trained.

[(2)] (3) The Oregon State Board of Nursing shall prepare curricula and standards for training programs for nursing assistants. [Such] The curricula and standards [shall] must provide for additional training for nursing assistants to have the authority to administer noninjectable medications.

[(3)] (4) The Department of Human Services may impose civil penalties or revoke the license of any long term care facility that employs [any] an untrained nursing assistant for a period of more than eight weeks without providing for the training prescribed by the board. Any license [which] that is revoked shall be revoked as provided in ORS 441.030.

[(4)] (5) The Oregon Health Authority may impose civil penalties or revoke the license of [any]a health care facility that employs any untrained nursing assistant for a period of more than eight weeks without providing for the training prescribed by the board. Any license [which] that is revoked shall be revoked as provided in ORS 441.030.

[(5) As used in this section, "nursing assistant" means a person who assists licensed nursing personnel in the provision of nursing care.]

SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 678.010 to 678.445.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) An individual may not use the title "medication aide" or "Certified Medication Aide" or the abbreviation "CMA" unless the individual:

(a) Is a nursing assistant;

(b) Has successfully completed training prescribed by the Oregon State Board of Nursing pursuant to ORS 678.440 for the administration of noninjectable medications; and

(c) Is authorized by the board to administer noninjectable medications.

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(2) An individual who is currently enrolled in a program approved by the board under ORS 678.444 that includes training in the administration of noninjectable medications may use the title "student medication aide."
