**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for State Fair Council, for *[conducting Oregon State Fair, carrying out state fairground business operations or operating state fairground properties and facilities]* **operation of State Fair Council and Oregon State Fair, start-up expenses, repair, deferred maintenance or insurance of fairground properties or capital expenditures for buildings, furniture, fixtures or equipment.**

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, and notwithstanding ORS 565.495 (5), there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the State Fair Council, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,750,000, which may be expended for operation of the State Fair Council and the Oregon State Fair and for start-up expenses.**

**SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, and notwithstanding ORS 565.495 (5), there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the State Fair Council, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,475,000, which may be expended for the repair, deferred maintenance or insurance of state fairground properties and facilities or for capital expenditures for buildings, furniture, fixtures or equipment.**

**SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.**
