SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides for annual adjustment of judges' salaries based on Consumer Price Index.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to judges' salaries.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 292.

5 SECTION 2. Before July 1 of each calendar year, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court

6 shall determine if there is a percentage increase in the cost of living for the previous calen-

7 dar year, based on changes in the Portland-Salem, OR-WA Consumer Price Index for All

8 Urban Consumers for All Items, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United

9 States Department of Labor. If the Chief Justice determines that there is a percentage in-

10 crease in the cost of living for the previous calendar year, on or before July 1 the Chief

11 Justice shall adjust the salaries of the judges of the Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals,

12 the circuit courts and the Oregon Tax Court by multiplying those salaries by the percentage

13 amount determined under this section. The adjusted salaries become effective on July 1 of 14 the year in which the adjustment is made.

15 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The first adjustment of judges' salaries under section 2 of this 2015 Act shall

16 **be made on July 1, 2016.**
