## Senate Bill 476

Sponsored by Senator EDWARDS (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Exempts local government from requirement to obtain aquatic invasive species prevention permit for certain boats.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 830.565 is amended to read:

6 830.565. (1) **Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section,** a person may not operate 7 a manually propelled boat that is 10 feet or more in length or a motorboat on the waters of this

a manually propelled boat that is 10 feet or more in length or a motorboat on the waters of this
state without first obtaining an aquatic invasive species prevention permit from the State Marine

9 Board under ORS 830.570.

(2) A person who obtains an aquatic invasive species prevention permit for a manually propelled
 boat may use the permit on any manually propelled boat the person operates on the waters of this
 state.

(3) The requirement to obtain an aquatic invasive species prevention permit under this
 section does not apply to manually propelled boats owned by a local government, as defined
 in ORS 174.116, that are used primarily by the public for recreational or educational pur poses.
