Senate Bill 505

Sponsored by Senators MONNES ANDERSON, BATES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires, from October 1 through March 1 of each year, each hospital in this state to make offer to each patient of hospital who is 65 years of age or older to immunize patient against influenza virus.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the influenza virus.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 441.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, from October 1 through March

6 1 of each year, each hospital in this state shall make an offer to each patient of the hospital

7 who is 65 years of age or older to immunize the patient against the influenza virus, provided

8 that immunization against the influenza virus is not contraindicated for that patient.

9 (2) Offers made under subsection (1) of this section must be based on:

10 (a) The availability of the influenza vaccine at the time the offer is made; and

11 (b) Any applicable recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Prac-

12 tices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

13 (3) The Oregon Health Authority may adopt rules to implement this section.

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
