Senate Bill 558

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires health benefit plan to reimburse cost of pharmacist consultation that meets specified criteria.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to pharmacists.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

6 (a) "Health benefit plan" has the meaning given that term in ORS 743.730.

7 (b) "Integrated health care delivery system" means a patient centered primary care 8 home or a similar model of health care delivery in which each patient's health care is man-9 aged by a group of providers working together to provide comprehensive and integrated care.

10 (c) "Pharmacist" means a person licensed by the State Board of Pharmacy to engage in

11 the practice of pharmacy.

(2) A health benefit plan that reimburses the cost of prescription drugs shall reimburse
the cost of a pharmacist's consultation with a patient enrolled in the plan or the patient's
physician if:

15 (a) The pharmacist is part of an integrated health care delivery system;

16 (b) The purpose of the consultation is to manage the patient's chronic condition; and

17 (c) The pharmacist is working under the direct supervision of a physician.

18 (3) This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to health benefit plans issued or renewed
on or after January 1, 2016.

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
