2 "Whereas communities and local entities can benefit from the support of the Oregon Health 3 Authority following a suicide; and 4 Whereas this legislation is designed to ensure that expertise in suicide prevention, intervention $\mathbf{5}$ and post-intervention is readily available in a timely manner; now, therefore,". 6 Delete lines 4 through 16 and insert: "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'local mental health authority' has the meaning 7 given that term in ORS 430.630. 8 9 "(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall develop a plan for communication among local 10 mental health authorities and local systems to improve notifications and information-sharing 11 when a death that is suspected to be a suicide involves an individual who is 24 years of age 12 or younger. The plan must address community suicide response and post-intervention efforts 13 to address loss and the potential of contagion risk. The following entities may be involved in 14 developing and implementing the plan: 15"(a) Public school districts; "(b) Public universities listed in ORS 352.002, if the death involves an individual who is 16

17 24 years of age or younger;

"(c) Private post-secondary institutions of education, if the death involves an individual
who is 24 years of age or younger; and

"(d) Any facility that provides services or resources to runaway or homeless youth.

"(3) Within seven days after a death that is suspected to be a suicide of an individual 24 years of age or younger, the local mental health authority in the area where the suicide occurred shall inform the Oregon Health Authority, in a manner and in a format to be determined by the authority, of activities implemented to support local entities and individuals affected by the suicide and to prevent the risk of contagion. The authority shall serve as a resource to the local mental health authority as needed by the community.".
