SUMMARY

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 660.300 to**
5 **660.364.**

6 **SECTION 2. For the purposes of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014**
7 **(P.L. 113-128), an individual enrolled in an alternative education program as provided by ORS**
8 **336.615 to 336.675 may be considered to be an out-of-school youth.**
