Senate Bill 831

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires coordinated care organization to employ or contract with clinical mental health professionals to provide mental health care and treatment to members of organization.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to mental health care.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.

5 SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "clinical mental health professional" means:

- 6 (a) A licensed psychiatrist;
- 7 (b) A licensed psychologist;

8 (c) A licensed health professional for whom clinical mental health treatment is within the

9 professional's authorized scope of practice; or

(d) An intern or resident who is working under a board-approved residency contract in
a clinical mental health field.

(2) A coordinated care organization fails to meet the requirement of ORS 414.625 to provide integrated person centered care and services if the organization does not employ or contract with clinical mental health professionals to provide mental health care and treatment to the members of the organization.

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
