

Senate Bill 869

Sponsored by Senator GIROD

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of State Police to create and maintain database of physical information of all schools. Requires database to be electronically accessible to all law enforcement agencies.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a school floor plan database; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of State Police shall create and maintain a database of**
5 **all schools in Oregon that shows the floor plan of each school, including the location of exits,**
6 **windows, ventilation, power sources and any other physical information necessary for a law**
7 **enforcement agency to respond to an emergency situation at the school.**

8 **(2) The database must be electronically accessible to all law enforcement agencies.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
