

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 93

1 Delete lines 5 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) A prescription drug benefit program, or a prescription drug benefit of-**
3 **ferred under a health benefit plan as defined in ORS 743.730, must provide for reimbursement**
4 **for up to a 90-day supply of a prescription drug dispensed by a pharmacy, as defined in ORS**
5 **689.005, if:**

6 **“(a) The prescription drug is covered by the program or plan;**

7 **“(b) The prescription drug has been previously dispensed to the program or plan member**
8 **with the same dosage instruction for not less than 90 days;**

9 **“(c) The quantity of the prescription drug dispensed does not exceed the total remaining**
10 **quantity of the prescription drug that the prescribing practitioner authorized to be dispensed**
11 **through refills; and**

12 **“(d) The drug is a generic drug.**

13 **“(2) The coverage required by subsection (1) of this section may be limited by the terms**
14 **and conditions of a pharmacy network contract, or a prescription drug benefit program or**
15 **health benefit plan, that are related to the reimbursement rate of the prescription drug.**

16 **“(3) The coverage required by subsection (1) of this section may be limited by formulary**
17 **restrictions that are related to the prescription drug.**

18 **“(4) This section does not apply to the reimbursement of prescription drugs classified as**
19 **a controlled substance in Schedule II.**

20 **“(5) This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.”.**
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
