1 Delete lines 4 through 17 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part
 of ORS chapter 536.

"SECTION 2. (1) The Water Resources Department may issue grants from available moneys to facilitate the preparation of place-based integrated water resources strategies that are consistent with state laws concerning the water resources of this state, state water resources policy and department requirements. The department may issue grants under this subsection to:

10 **"(a) A person;**

11 "(b) A public body as defined in ORS 174.109; or

12 "(c) An Indian tribe.

"(2) The department may enter into contracts or agreements with,
 provide technical assistance to and provide information to a person,
 a public body as defined in ORS 174.109 or an Indian tribe for the de velopment of place-based integrated water resources strategies.

"(3) Place-based integrated water resources strategies described in
 subsections (1) and (2) of this section must:

"(a) Be developed in collaboration with a balanced representation
 of interests;

"(b) Balance current and future in-stream and out-of-stream needs;
"(c) Include the development of actions that are consistent with the

existing state laws concerning the water resources of this state and
 state water resources policy;

3 "(d) Facilitate implementation of local solutions;

"(e) Be developed utilizing an open and transparent process that
fosters public participation; and

6 "(f) Be developed in consultation with the department.

7 "(4) The Water Resources Commission may adopt rules for the ad8 ministration of this section.

9 "SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is repealed January 2, 2025.
10 The repeal of section 2 of this 2015 Act does not affect any rights or
11 responsibilities established in a grant, contract or agreement made
12 under section 2 of this 2015 Act prior to January 2, 2025.".
