PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 512

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, delete lines 7 through 20 and insert:

<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) As used in this section, 'negative report' includes
a report of tampering with an ignition interlock device, unauthorized
removal of an ignition interlock device or a test violation recorded by
an ignition interlock device.

"(2) Notwithstanding ORS 813.602 (1)(c) and (2), the requirement to 6 have an ignition interlock device installed in a vehicle continues until 7 the person submits to the Department of Transportation a certificate 8 from the ignition interlock device provider stating that the device did 9 not record a negative report for the last six consecutive months of the 10 required installation period. If there is a negative report during the 11 last six consecutive months, the person shall continue to use an ig-12nition interlock device beyond the period required under ORS 813.602 13 until the person submits a certificate to the department from the ig-14 nition interlock device provider stating that the device has not re-15corded a negative report for six consecutive months, beginning from 16 the date of the most recent negative report. 17

"(3) The department may adopt rules to carry out the provisions
 of this section.".
