PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3041

1 Delete lines 5 through 21 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, 'allowed nonprescription
sunscreen' means sunscreen that may be purchased without a prescription and that does not contain para-aminobenzoic acid.

"(2) Each school district shall allow the following during school
hours, at a school-sponsored activity or while under the supervision
of school personnel:

8 "(a) The outdoor use by students of sun-protective clothing, in9 cluding hats; and

"(b) The application of and use by students of allowed
 nonprescription sunscreen.

"(3) For the purposes of subsection (2) of this section, each school
 district board shall adopt policies related to:

"(a) The type of sun-protective clothing that may be used outdoors
by students in the schools of the school district. A policy adopted under this paragraph may be adopted as part of the school district's dress
code and may provide that the sun-protective clothing must comply
with other requirements of the school district's dress code.

19 "(b) The application of and use by students of allowed
 20 nonprescription sunscreen. A policy adopted under this paragraph:

"(A) May not require a student to provide any documentation from
a licensed health care professional; and

"(B) May allow school personnel to assist students in applying al lowed nonprescription sunscreen but may not require school personnel
 to assist students in applying sunscreen.

4 "(4) School personnel may not be held liable in a criminal action 5 or for civil damages for application of allowed nonprescription 6 sunscreen or sunscreen that contains para-aminobenzoic acid if the 7 sunscreen is available to and used by the student in accordance with 8 policies adopted under this section.".
