19 "(b) Are integrated with local school curricula in a manner that 20 assists students in meeting state standards related to science, tech-21 nology, engineering and mathematics, and international standards re-22 lated to science. "(c) Provide students with opportunities to develop leadership,
 critical thinking and decision-making skills.

"(d) Address the inequity of outdoor educational opportunities for
underserved children in this state.

"(3) Grants shall be awarded from the Outdoor Education Account
established under section 3 of this 2015 Act and shall be awarded to a
school district or to an education service district.

8 "(4) Priority for grants shall be given to outdoor school programs
9 that promote:

"(a) Higher scores on standardized measures of academic achieve ment in reading, writing, math, science and social studies.

When 4 selecting the members of the committee, the director shall take into  $\mathbf{5}$ consideration geographic and demographic diversity and shall ensure 6 that the committee has representatives of the environmental commu-7 nity, the natural resources community and fifth-grade or sixth-grade 8 education. 9

10 "(b) The advisory committee shall recommend to the director:

11 "(A) Standards for outdoor school programs; and

12 "(B) Distributions of moneys for outdoor school programs.

13 **"(6)** The director shall submit an annual report to:

"(a) The Department of Education, related to the ability of outdoor
 school programs to assist students in meeting state standards related

<sup>20</sup> "<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) The Outdoor Education Account is established in <sup>21</sup> the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. In-<sup>22</sup> terest earned by the Outdoor Education Account shall be credited to <sup>23</sup> the account.

"(2) Moneys in the Outdoor Education Account are continuously appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for use by the Oregon State University Extension Service to award grants for outdoor school programs under section 2 of this 2015 Act.".
