PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 322

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the 2 rest of the line and line 3 and insert "and prescribing an effective date.".

3 Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part
5 of ORS 327.006 to 327.133.

6 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) As used in this section, 'fifth year high school 7 program' means a program in which a student who has satisfied the 8 requirements for a diploma established by the State Board of Educa-9 tion under ORS 329.451:

10 "(a) Does not receive a diploma;

11 "(b) Remains enrolled at a school district;

"(c) Attends a community college for at least half of the student's
 coursework; and

"(d) Has some or all of the student's tuition, fees and books for
 coursework at the community college paid by the school district where
 the student is enrolled.

"(2)(a) Notwithstanding ORS 327.006 (1) and except as provided by paragraph (b) of this subsection, calculations of aggregate days membership may not include students who are participating in a fifth year high school program.

"(b) Calculations of aggregate days membership may include stu dents who are participating in a fifth year high school program if,

during the 2014-2015 school year, students of the school district participated in a fifth year high school program. Calculations made under
this paragraph shall be limited as follows:

4 "(A) For the 2016-2017 school year, the number of students for whom 5 calculations of aggregate days membership include students who are 6 participating in a fifth year high school program must be decreased 7 by at least 50 percent in comparison to the number of students who 8 participated in a fifth year high school program during the 2015-2016 9 school year.

"(B) For the 2017-2018 school year, the number of students for whom calculations of aggregate days membership include students who are participating in a fifth year high school program must be decreased by at least 50 percent in comparison to the number of students who participated in a fifth year high school program during the 2016-2017 school year.

"(C) For the 2018-2019 school year, calculations of aggregate days
 membership may not include any students who are participating in a
 fifth year high school program.

"(3) A school district that receives funding based on calculations
 as provided by subsection (2) of this section shall:

"(a) Explore options for students to have post-secondary education
 experiences and earn post-secondary education credit while in high
 school; and

"(b) Submit a report to the Department of Education following the
2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years to document how the
school district is complying with the requirements of subsection (2)
of this section and with paragraph (a) of this subsection.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is repealed on July 1, 2019.
"<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2015 Act takes effect on July 1, 2016.".

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
