PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 322

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and line 3 and insert "and prescribing an effective date.".
- 3 Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 327.006 to 327.133.
- "SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, 'fifth year high school program' means a program in which a student who has satisfied the requirements for a diploma established by the State Board of Education under ORS 329.451:
- 10 "(a) Does not receive a diploma;
- "(b) Remains enrolled at a school district;
- "(c) Attends a community college for at least half of the student's coursework; and
- "(d) Has some or all of the student's tuition, fees and books for coursework at the community college paid by the school district where the student is enrolled.
- "(2) Notwithstanding ORS 327.006 (1), calculations of aggregate days
 membership may not include students who are participating in a fifth
 year high school program.
- "SECTION 3. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2) of this section, section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to State School Fund distributions commencing with the 2016-2017 distributions.

- "(2) Calculations of aggregate days membership may include stu-1 dents who are participating in a fifth year high school program if, 2 during the 2014-2015 school year, students of the school district par-3 ticipated in a fifth year high school program. Calculations made under 4 this subsection shall be limited as follows: 5
- "(a) For the 2016-2017 school year, the number of students for whom 6 calculations of aggregate days membership include students who are participating in a fifth year high school program must be decreased 8 by at least 50 percent in comparison to the number of students who participated in a fifth year high school program during the 2015-2016 school year.
 - "(b) For the 2017-2018 school year, the number of students for whom calculations of aggregate days membership include students who are participating in a fifth year high school program must be decreased by at least 50 percent in comparison to the number of students who participated in a fifth year high school program during the 2016-2017 school year.
- "(c) For the 2018-2019 school year, calculations of aggregate days 18 membership may not include any students who are participating in a 19 fifth year high school program. 20
 - "(3) A school district that receives funding based on calculations as provided by subsection (2) of this section shall:
 - "(a) Explore options for students to have post-secondary education experiences and earn post-secondary education credit while in high school; and
- "(b) Submit a report to the Department of Education following the 26 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years to document how the 27 school district is complying with the requirements of subsection (2) 28 of this section and with paragraph (a) of this subsection. 29
 - "SECTION 4. This 2015 Act takes effect on July 1, 2016.".
