## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2407

1 On page 4 of the printed bill, after line 6, insert:

"(6)(a) The Executive Director of the Office of Student Access and Completion shall inform eligible post-secondary institutions of the identity of qualified students who attend the institution and who receive a grant under this section for more than one academic year.

6 "(b) To the extent possible, eligible post-secondary institutions shall en-7 sure that qualified students identified under this subsection are made aware 8 of the academic guidance and counseling services available at the 9 institution.".

10 In line 7, delete "(6)" and insert "(7)".

In line 13, delete "(7)" and insert "(8)".

12 After line 14, insert:

"(9)(a) The commission shall report annually on or before February 1 to committees of the Legislative Assembly related to higher education regarding the academic success and performance of qualified students who receive grants under this section.

"(b) In order to meet the reporting requirements set forth in paragraph(a) of this subsection:

"(A) The commission shall by rule design a method for evaluating the academic success and performance of students who receive a grant under this section; and

22 "(B) Upon a request from the commission, eligible post-secondary insti-

tutions must provide the commission with the data necessary for the commission to conduct its analysis.".

3 Delete lines 15 and 16 and insert:

"SECTION 5. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,
the amendments to ORS 348.205 and 348.260 by sections 1 and 4 of this
2015 Act first apply to Oregon Opportunity Grants awarded for the
2016-2017 academic year.

"(2) The first report to the committees of the Legislative Assembly
related to higher education required under ORS 348.260, as amended
by section 4 of this 2015 Act, must be filed by February 1, 2020.".
