## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 289

On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and lines 3 through 26 and insert "and declaring an emergency.".

4 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2.

5 Delete lines 4 through 45 and delete pages 3 through 39 and insert:

6 **"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:** 

"(a) 'Executive department' has the meaning given that term in
8 ORS 174.112.

9 "(b) 'Small entity' means an agency, department or other adminis-10 trative subdivision within the executive department for which ap-11 pointments to the organization are overseen by the Executive 12 Appointments Office of the Governor's Office or that has five or fewer 13 full-time equivalent employees.

"(2) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall de velop and administer, or contract with a third party to administer, a
 training program that provides training and instruction on:

17 "(a) Oregon government ethics laws;

"(b) Restrictions on political activity that apply to public officials
 and public employees;

20 "(c) Oregon public records laws;

21 "(d) Oregon public meetings laws;

<sup>22</sup> "(e) Operations and management; and

"(f) Other topics that the department determines may be beneficial
for new members or employees of boards, commissions and other small
entities of the executive department.

"(3) The training program shall be designed to facilitate understanding of and compliance with the requirements of the laws that are
the subject of the training. Training may be conducted at graduated
levels that are commensurate with the level of experience of trainees.
"(4) The training program shall be offered at least twice per year
to all new members or employees of any board, commission or other
small entity of the executive department.

"(5) Each member or employee of a board, commission or other 11 small entity of the executive department shall attend the training de-12scribed in this section within six months of the start of the member's 13 service, or employee's employment, with a board, commission or other 14 small entity of the executive department. A member or employee who 15has attended the training once need not attend the training again in 16 the event of a transfer to another board, commission or other small 17 entity of the executive department, if there has been no break in ser-18 vice of longer than six months and no significant change in duties or 19 responsibilities that warrants receiving a different level of training. 20

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act becomes operative January
1, 2016.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
