## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2930

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "and 441.055".

2 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

3 "SECTION 1. ORS 441.064 is amended to read:

4 "441.064. (1) As used in this section, 'physician' has the meaning
5 given that term in ORS 677.010.

6 "[(1)] (2) The rules of any hospital in this state may grant [admitting] 7 privileges to nurse practitioners licensed and certified under ORS 678.375 for 8 purposes of patient care[, subject to hospital and medical staff bylaws, rules 9 and regulations governing admissions and staff privileges].

"[(2)] (3) Rules shall be in writing and may include, but need not be limited to:

12 "(a) Limitations on the scope of privileges;

"(b) Monitoring and supervision of nurse practitioners in the hospital by
 physicians who are members of the medical staff;

15 "(c) A requirement that a nurse practitioner co-admit patients with a 16 physician who is a member of the medical staff; and

"(d) Qualifications of nurse practitioners to be eligible for privileges in cluding but not limited to requirements of prior clinical and hospital expe rience.

"[(3)] (4) The rules may also regulate [*the admissions*] **credentialing** and the conduct of nurse practitioners while using the facilities of the hospital and may prescribe procedures whereby a nurse practitioner's privileges may be suspended or terminated. The hospital may refuse such privileges to nurse
practitioners only upon the same basis that privileges are refused to other
medical providers.

4 "[(4) For purposes of this section, 'physician' has the meaning given the 5 term in ORS 677.010.]

"(5) Notwithstanding subsection (3) of this section, rules adopted
by a hospital that grant privileges to licensed registered nurses who
are certified by the Oregon State Board of Nursing as nurse midwife
nurse practitioners must:

10 "(a) Include admitting privileges;

"(b) Be consistent with the privileges of the other medical staff; and
 "(c) Permit the nurse midwife nurse practitioner to exercise the
 voting rights of the other members of the medical staff.

"(6) Rules described in this section are subject to hospital and
 medical staff bylaws and rules governing credentialing and staff priv ileges.".

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
