PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 665

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the 2 rest of the line and insert "and declaring an emergency.".

3 Delete lines 4 through 27 and delete pages 2 through 6 and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall convene a task 4 force to investigate and make recommendations on the feasibility of $\mathbf{5}$ obtaining approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Ser-6 vices to waive the Medicare requirements mandating the use of the 7 prospective payment system for reimbursing hospitals, to enable this 8 state to implement a statewide system to regulate hospital charges. 9 The task force shall also develop and recommend a reimbursement 10 method that uses global budgets to reimburse the cost of hospital care. 11 "(2) The task force shall include, but is not limited to: 12

"(a) The Insurance Commissioner appointed by the Director of the
 Department of Consumer and Business Services in accordance with
 ORS 705.105, or the commissioner's designee, as an ex officio member;
 "(b) The Director of the Oregon Health Authority or the director's
 designee, as an ex officio member;

"(c) Representatives for organizations that represent health care
 consumers;

20 "(d) Hospital representatives;

21 "(e) A health care economist;

²² "(f) Representatives for insurers that offer health benefit plans;

- 1 "(g) A physician representative; and
- 2 "(h) Representatives for small and large employers.

"(3) The authority shall apply for a Medicare demonstration project
if recommended by the task force.

"(4) The authority shall report to the Senate interim committee on
health care no later than September 15, 2015, and to the committees
of the Legislative Assembly related to health care, no later than February 1, 2016, on:

9 "(a) The recommendations of the task force; and

"(b) The progress in establishing a Medicare demonstration project
 and developing a reimbursement method using global budgets.

"(5) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes
 a quorum for the transaction of business.

"(6) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a
 majority of the voting members of the task force.

"(7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as
 chairperson.

"(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the
 call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the
 task force.

"(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of
the task force.

23 "(10) The authority shall provide staff support to the task force.

"(11) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force consider necessary to perform their duties.

"<u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2,
 2016.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
