- "(B) The number of workers trained by affiliate programs;
- 15 "(c) The annual amount of independent support funds raised for research 16 and fees for services in support of the center;
- "(d) Community involvement and the number of independent businesses involved with educational and response activity through the center on an annual basis;
- 20 "(e) The number of businesses that create business continuity plans or 21 that use the center's cyber-security tools annually; and
 - "(f) The ability of the center to develop methods to track potential risk

and the resulting amount of money saved by Oregon businesses annually.".
