PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 418

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after "provisions;" delete the rest 2 of the line and insert "and amending ORS 675.040.".

3 Delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. Sections 2 and 3 of this 2015 Act are added to and 5 made a part of ORS 675.010 to 675.150.

6 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> When exercising its authority under ORS 675.010 to 7 675.150, the State Board of Psychologist Examiners may not discrimi-8 nate against a doctoral program in psychology, or an institution of 9 higher education that houses a doctoral program in psychology, based 10 on the geographic location of the program or institution or based on 11 whether the program or institution offers online courses or requires 12 students to complete courses on the campus of the institution.

"SECTION 3. The State Board of Psychologist Examiners may not deny approval of a doctoral program in psychology solely because the program is not accredited by a professional organization of psychologists, if the program is housed within an institution of higher education that is accredited by a regional higher education accrediting agency that is recognized by the United States Department of Education.

²⁰ "SECTION 4. ORS 675.040 is amended to read:

"675.040. (1) Examinations administered by the State Board of Psychol ogist Examiners for applicants for licenses under ORS 675.010 to 675.150 shall

be held at least once every year at such times and places as the board may
determine. Timely and appropriate notice shall be sent to each applicant.

"(2) The board shall permit an applicant who holds a doctoral degree in psychology from an approved doctoral program in psychology, regardless of the structure for the year in residence at the institution of education in which the program is housed, to take the board administered examination.

8 "[(2)] (3) Any applicant may, upon written request to the board, discuss 9 the applicant's performance on the board administered examination with the 10 board.

"[(3)] (4) Any applicant who fails to make a passing grade on the board administered examination shall be allowed to take the examination a second time. Any applicant who fails the examination a second time must obtain special permission from the board to take the examination again.

"SECTION 5. (1) Sections 2 and 3 of this 2015 Act apply to actions
 taken by the State Board of Psychologist Examiners on or after the
 effective date of this 2015 Act.

"(2) The amendments to ORS 675.040 by section 4 of this 2015 Act
 apply to applicants who receive doctoral degrees in psychology on or
 after the effective date of this 2015 Act.".
