

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 84**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, line 26, delete “enable” and insert “offer”  
2 and after “12” insert “the opportunity”.

3 Delete lines 41 and 42 and insert:

4 “(3)(a) Courses offered through an accelerated college credit program may  
5 be supported by online resources. If a course is exclusively provided online,  
6 the course must provide supports that are targeted to improving the success  
7 of students taking the course.”.

8 In line 45, after “reasonable” insert “and timely” and after “enable” insert  
9 “a school district to offer to”.

10 On page 3, line 1, after “12” insert “the opportunity”.

11 After line 3, insert:

12 “(4) A school district or a high school may enter into an agreement with  
13 a post-secondary institution of education to provide courses through an ac-  
14 celerated college credit program. If the school district or high school is un-  
15 able to reach an agreement with the public university located closest to the  
16 high school or with the community college that serves the high school within  
17 60 days of beginning negotiations for an agreement, the school district or  
18 high school may pursue an agreement with another public university or  
19 community college in this state, regardless of any established service  
20 areas.”.

21 In line 4, delete “(4)” and insert “(5)” and delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.

22 In line 8, delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.

1 In line 17, delete “(6)” and insert “(7)”.

2 On page 4, line 23, delete “nationally established standards” and insert  
3 “nationally-established standards or state-established accelerated credit  
4 standards” and after “The” insert “statewide”.

5 Delete lines 33 through 40 and insert:

6 “(c) High school teachers of courses that are part of an accelerated col-  
7 lege credit program must be approved as an instructor by a post-secondary  
8 institution of education based on nationally-established standards, state-  
9 established standards or a process established by the commission. A process  
10 established by the commission must be established in consultation with the  
11 State Board of Education and post-secondary institutions of education and  
12 must identify instructor requirements specific to entry-level courses that are  
13 part of an accelerated college credit program and that are offered as required  
14 by ORS 340.300 (2)(a).”

15 In line 41, after “for” insert “the first three courses, or the first nine  
16 quarter hours, that students take through”.

17 In line 42, delete “high schools and to”.

18 In line 43, delete “received from the State School Fund”.

19 On page 5, after line 24, insert:

20 **“SECTION 5a. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this sec-  
21 tion, the requirements of ORS 340.310, as amended by section 5 of this  
22 2015 Act, first apply to the 2015-2016 school year.**

23 **“(2) The requirements of ORS 340.310 (1)(c), as amended by section  
24 5 of this 2015 Act, first apply to the 2016-2017 school year.”.**

25 On page 11, line 44, delete “high school” and insert “college”.

26 In line 45, delete “for a college-level course”.

27 On page 12, line 1, delete “high school” and insert “college”.

28 In line 2, delete “for a college-level course” and insert “that is”.

29 In line 6, delete “high school” and insert “college”.

30 In line 7, delete “college-level”.

1 In line 14, delete “high school” and insert “college”.

2 In line 15, delete “for a college-level course”.

3 In line 18, delete “and” and insert a comma and after the second “pro-  
4 grams” insert “and accelerated college credit programs”.

5 In line 19, after “textbooks” insert “, instructional materials and  
6 supplies”.

7 In line 21, delete “and” and insert a comma and after the second “pro-  
8 grams” insert “and accelerated college credit programs”.

9 In line 24, delete “quarter hour of”.

10 In line 25, delete “nine quarter hours” and insert “three high school  
11 credits”.

12 After line 27, insert:

13 “(3) Distributions made as provided in subsection (2) of this section shall  
14 be made:

15 “(a) For the first nine credits for dual credit courses or for the first three  
16 high school credits for advanced placement program or International  
17 Baccalaureate program courses, whichever occurs first; and

18 “(b) From a school district to a public charter school based on the per-  
19 centage that payments are made under agreements entered into as provided  
20 in ORS 338.155.”.

21 In line 28, delete “(3)” and insert “(4)”.

22 In line 32, delete “(4)” and insert “(5)”.

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
