## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 700

1 Delete lines 4 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriate priation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, which may be expended for the purpose of providing assistance for the purchase of fresh, unprocessed, locally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs from farmers' markets or roadside stands under the Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program.

9 "(2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there 10 is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium be-11 ginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000, 12 which may be expended for the purpose of providing assistance for the 13 purchase of fresh, unprocessed, locally grown fruits, vegetables and 14 herbs from farmers' markets or roadside stands under the Women, 15 Infants and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program.

16 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appro-17 priation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the 18 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount 19 of \$200,000, to be allocated to Oregon Health Authority for:

"(a) Matching funds for a grant from the United States Department
 of Agriculture through the federal WIC Farmers' Market Nutrition
 Program or the federal Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program or

from any other federal or state agency, where the grant relates to the provision of fresh, unprocessed, locally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs;

4 "(b) Expansion of the Farm Direct Nutrition Program and the
5 Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program described in ORS 411.813; or

6 "(c) Any other means of providing assistance for the purchase of 7 fresh, unprocessed, locally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs.

"(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this
section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December
1, 2016, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any
purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.".
