PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3068

1 Delete lines 4 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall
 conduct a study and develop recommendations for legislation to reduce
 woodstove smoke. The study shall evaluate:

"(a) Strategies to reduce woodstove smoke in communities where
attainment of the national air quality standards prescribed in the
federal Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. 7409, is a concern, including but not
limited to:

9 "(A) Options for transitioning from older, high-polluting 10 woodstoves to cleaner-burning home heating alternatives; and

"(B) Options for reducing the cost of using woodstove alternatives
 for home heating during poor air quality days;

13 **"(b) The use of biomass in home heating;**

"(c) Opportunities to develop the production and use of high-quality
 wood pellet fuel in Oregon;

"(d) The role of subsidies to encourage wood pellet use in house holds; and

"(e) Potential economic and public health effects of woodstove
 smoke in communities where attainment of the national air quality
 standards prescribed in the federal Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. 7409, is a
 concern.

22 "(2) The Department of Environmental Quality shall form a work

group for the purpose of conducting the study described in this section. The work group shall include representatives from other state agencies, stakeholders, elected officials and other individuals who the department determines have expertise that will inform the study. Members of the work group shall represent urban and rural communities and different geographic regions of this state.

7 "(3) In conducting the study described in this section, the depart8 ment shall:

9 "(a) Collaborate with the State Department of Energy, State
 10 Forestry Department, Oregon Business Development Department and
 11 Public Utility Commission; and

"(b) Consult with members of the public from rural and urban
 communities, as well as different regions of the state, about its pre liminary findings and recommendations relating to potential strategies
 to reduce woodstove smoke.

16 "(4) The department shall submit an initial report on its prelimi-17 nary findings and recommendations to a legislative committee related 18 to the environment and natural resources in the manner provided 19 under ORS 192.245 during the 2016 regular session of the Seventy-20 eighth Legislative Assembly.

"(5) The department shall submit a final report on the results of the study and recommendations for legislation or budget requests to the interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to the environment and natural resources in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2016.".
