PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 660

1 Delete lines 4 through 11 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>"SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall establish an
oral health program for the purpose of collecting data about, monitoring and providing assistance to students who are at risk of tooth
decay. As part of the program, the authority shall:

"(a) Create a statewide plan for screening and providing dental
sealants to students that the authority determines are at risk of tooth
decay.

9 "(b) Screen and ensure the provision of dental sealants to students 10 who attend an elementary school or middle school in which at least 11 40 percent of all students attending the school are eligible to receive 12 assistance under the United States Department of Agriculture's Na-13 tional School Lunch Program.

"(c) Determine whether each school eligible to participate in the
 program may benefit from an independent oral health program that
 provides dental sealants to students.

"(d) For a school that the authority determines cannot benefit from
 an independent oral health program, directly provide dental sealants
 to students who attend that school.

"(e) For a school that the authority determines may benefit from
 an independent oral health program, establish standards for the oper ation of an independent oral health program.

"(f) Create processes and standards for certifying and recertifying individuals who administer dental sealants through the program, whether through the authority or through an independent oral health program, including any training necessary to administer dental sealants.

"(g) Certify individuals who administer dental sealants.

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"(h) Recertify individuals who administer dental sealants.

6 "(2) If the authority directly provides dental sealants to students 9 who attend a school eligible to participate in the program, and if the 10 authority determines that an independent oral health program is ca-11 pable of providing those services, then the authority shall develop a 12 plan to transition the provision of services from the authority to the 13 independent oral health program.

"(3) If the authority directly provides dental sealants to a student pursuant to subsection (1)(d) of this section, the authority shall determine whether the student is a member of a coordinated care organization and, if the student is a member of a coordinated care organization, inform the coordinated care organization that the student has received dental sealants through the program.".

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
