16 "<u>SECTION 12.</u> (1) In accordance with rules adopted by the State 17 Board of Pharmacy under ORS 689.205, a pharmacist may prescribe and 18 dispense self-administered oral hormonal contraceptives to a person 19 who is at least 18 years of age.

"(2)(a) The board shall adopt rules to establish, in consultation with
 the Oregon Medical Board and the Oregon Health Authority, standard
 procedures for the prescription and dispensation by pharmacists of

1 self-administered oral hormonal contraceptives.

2 "(b) The rules adopted under this subsection must require:

"(A) The pharmacist to provide a self-screening risk assessment
tool that the patient must use prior to the pharmacist's prescribing
and dispensing the self-administered oral hormonal contraceptive;

6 "(B) The pharmacist to refer the patient to the patient's primary 7 care practitioner upon prescribing and dispensing the self-8 administered oral hormonal contraceptive;

9 "(C) The pharmacist to provide the patient with a written record 10 of the self-administered oral hormonal contraceptive prescribed and 11 dispensed and advise the patient to consult with a primary care prac-12 titioner;

"(D) The pharmacist to dispense the self-administered oral
 hormonal contraceptive to the patient as expediently as practicable
 after issuing the prescription; and

"(E) That a pharmacist may choose not to prescribe and dispense
 a self-administered oral hormonal contraceptive for ethical, moral or
 religious reasons.

"(c) The rules adopted under this subsection must prohibit a pharmacist from requiring that a patient schedule an appointment with the pharmacist for the prescription and dispensation of a selfadministered oral hormonal contraceptive.".
